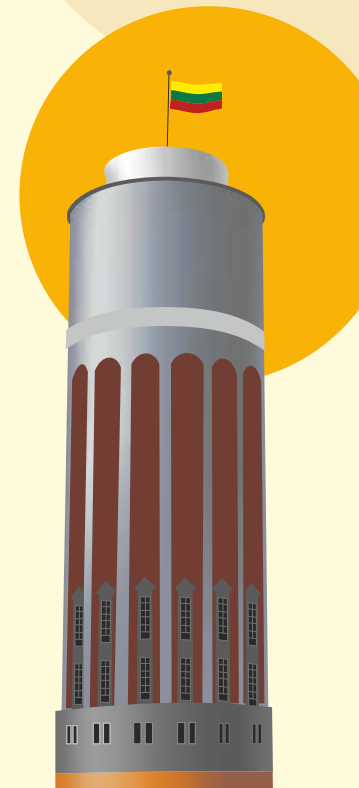

How to play: Find as many game pieces as there will be players. All are suitable: chestnuts, acorns, sweets and other small items from your pocket. If you don't have a dice, never mind. Ask your parents for 6 coins of the same denomination. Shake them in the palm of your hand, throw and see –the numbers that have turned up will determine the number of squares you will rush forward.


Every object has a meaning. You can get acquainted with the objects of the city of Šiauliai, which will allow you to ascend or make you descend, in advance.

Have fun playing! Discover Šiauliai while playing the game!

7-29 **The Iron Fox.** Jump on the fox's tail up! You have played cunningly!

 11 Fountain “Pelicans”. The pelicans got so tired after the flight that they squatted to rest. Have a rest you too, miss a turn.


▲ **17 Cats.** Cats are running on the roofs to smell valerian. Smell, run three squares forward you too.

 **22–42 Ch. Frenkel's Fountain.** When Chaim Frenkel returned to the villa, he turned on the fountain and a stream of water shot up. Rise up with it you too!

31–50 Water supply tower. The only round museum in Šiauliai. Climb higher, you will see the city better.

➤ **33–53 A yacht in Lake Rēkyva.** Have you seen the ship's boy climbing the mast to see what is sailing on the horizon? Climb to the top to look around!

▲ **35–97 “The Archer”.** The golden archer shoots accurately and you shoot at square 97 too.

 **36 “Three elves”.** The three elves love children, therefore they give you another chance to roll the dice.

40–60 The clock “The Cock”. Don’t be late for a date! Rise all the way to the clock-face and see what time the clock “The Cock” now shows.

52–68 The Bicycle. A small wheel grew into a large one. Ride your bike up!

62 "The Balts' Road". Have you already visited the unique centre "The Balts' Road"? Miss a turn and make sure you drop in there!

64–83 Graffiti “Butterflies”. Butterflies rose from the wall of the Drama Theatre and invited you to fly together.

69–90 Žaliūkiai mill. The wings of the mill caught the wind and flew you forward.

76-96 The Cathedral. Don't wake the bull sleeping under the Cathedral and climb the tower to see the city's panorama from a height.


▲ **81–102 “My Shoes”.** With these metal shoes, you will ascend the very top of the mountain. So go ahead!

▼ **87–67 Cents from “The Cents Room”.** The wallpaper of the cents room peeled off and cents scattered. Go down – collect them.

98 **"The paintbrush"**. The paintbrush was painting a lot and got tired. Have a rest you too, miss the turn.

➦ **104–116 Salduvè mound.** Have you counted stairs leading to Salduvè mound? Jump up right on top of the sweet mountain!

🔴 **107-23 The train.** What a problem – you were late for the train! You will have to run back to the station and buy another ticket.

 **108–92 The Chameleon.** The chameleon likes hanging with his head down. On the other hand, maybe he saw a tasty bite in the grass? Go down to have a look you too.

➡ **112-90 Chocolate from a sweet factory.** Chocolate got warm and melted! Flow with the sweet drops down you too.

113 A Footbridge at the Botanical Garden. Only goatlings were not agreeing with each other on the footbridge, but you smile and travel 5 squares forward!

 118 A Camera from the Museum of Photography. Cameras perpetuate our most beautiful moments. Pause for a moment – miss the turn.
